Specialized equipment and testing, including:

- distance acuity
- eye teaming
- eye movements
- focusing skills

Optometrists, Ophthalmologists can diagnose myopia or other eye conditions.

VISION SCREENINGS

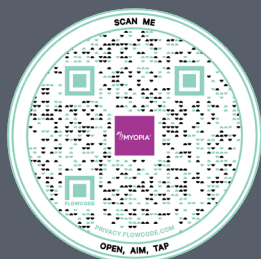


Administrative personnel or volunteers:

- may not be ophthalmic trained
- may not be able to assess screening results

Vision screenings only test distance and visual acuity.

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
